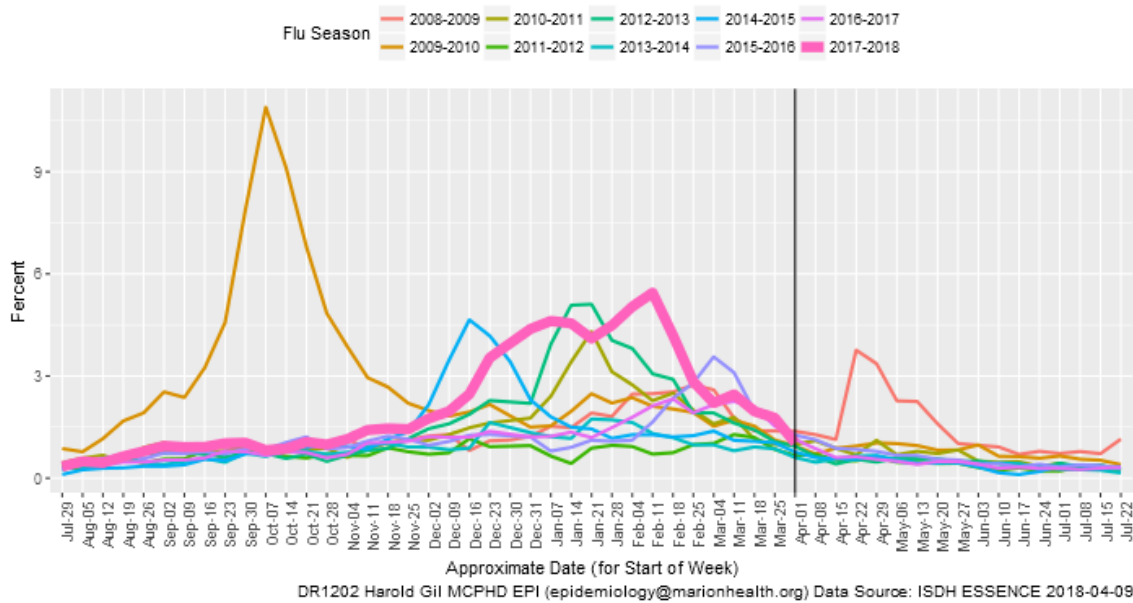
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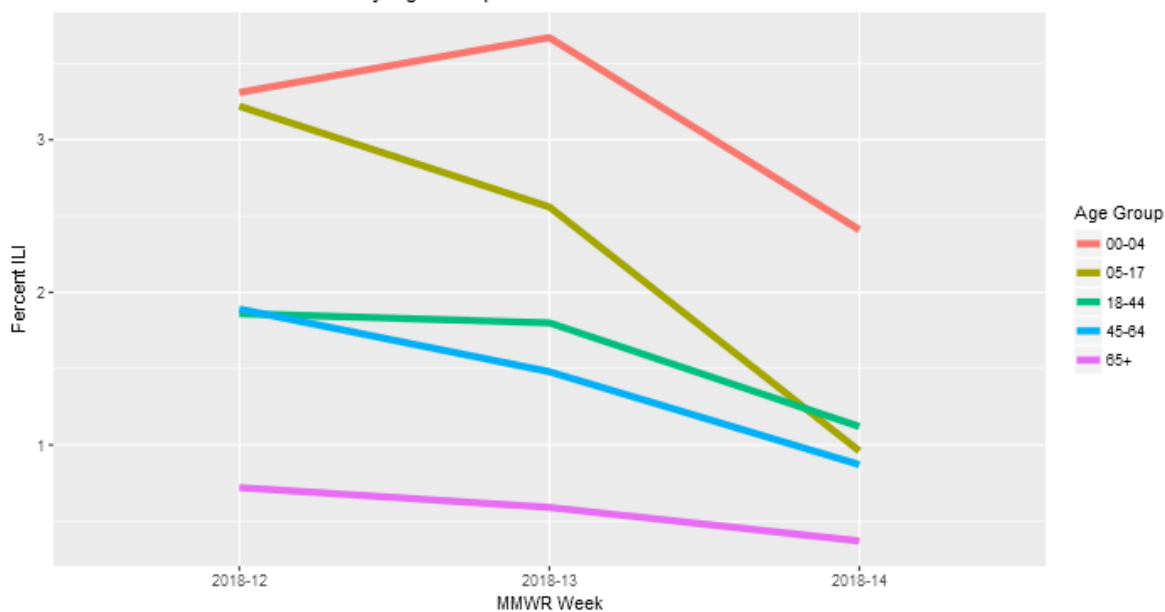
Updates on Most Recent Local Activity: Week 14 (Apr 01 – Apr 07)

- Influenza-like Illness (ILI) symptoms continue to decline in Marion County Emergency Departments, with the percentage of ED visits last week (Week 14) at 1.04%.
- There have been 24 influenza-associated deaths for Marion County residents this flu season.
- In Marion County hospitals' ED population, ILI was most common in the 0-4 age group. Among ED visits by 0-4 year olds, 2.42% were for ILI. ILI among ED visits by 18-44 year olds was next highest, at 1.12%.

Note: ILI (Influenza-Like Illness) visit means that the patient reported fever with cough or sore throat, or used the word "flu" or "influenza" to describe either their symptoms or their reason for the ED (Emergency Department) visit.

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
