Updates on Most Recent Local Activity: Week 42 (Oct 16 – Oct 22)

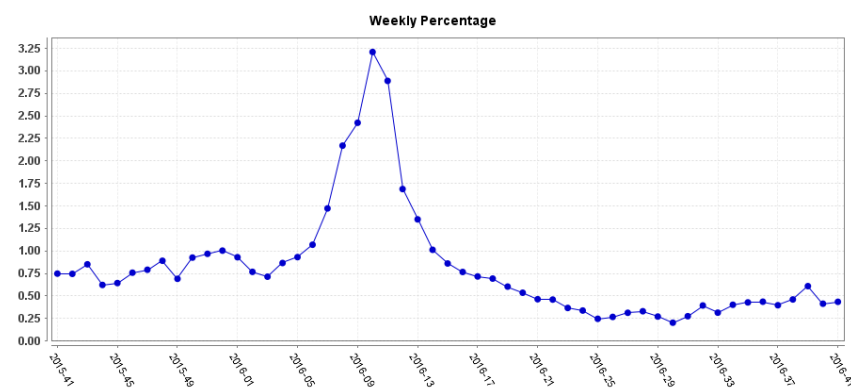
- The number of visits for ILI remains at a low level with a slight decline from last week. The percent and count of ILI visits for the most current week (Week 42) are 0.43% and 40, respectively.

Local (Week 41)

- The percent and count of ED visits with a chief complaint of ILI was 0.44% and 50 of all ED visits, respectively.
- Children under the age of 5 have the highest age-specific percent ILI (1.5%).

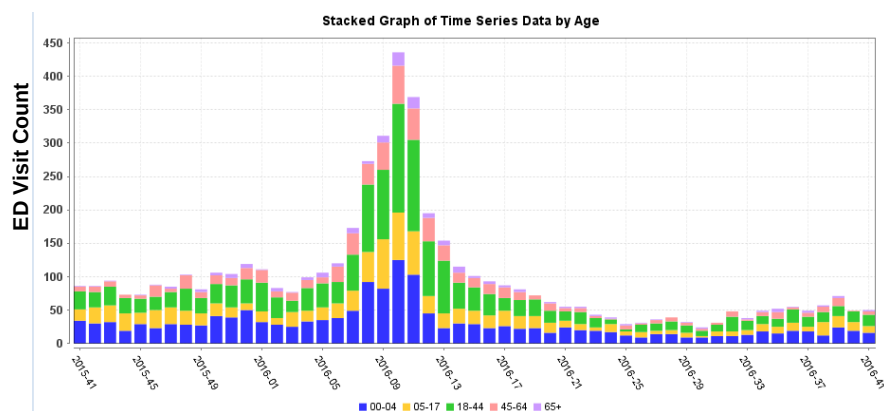

Figure 1 represents the percent of all ED visits that were categorized as ILI. The overall percent ILI for Week 41 is 0.4% (lower than last week).

ILI visit means that the patient reported fever with cough or sore throat, or used the word "flu" to describe either their symptoms or their reason for the ED visit.

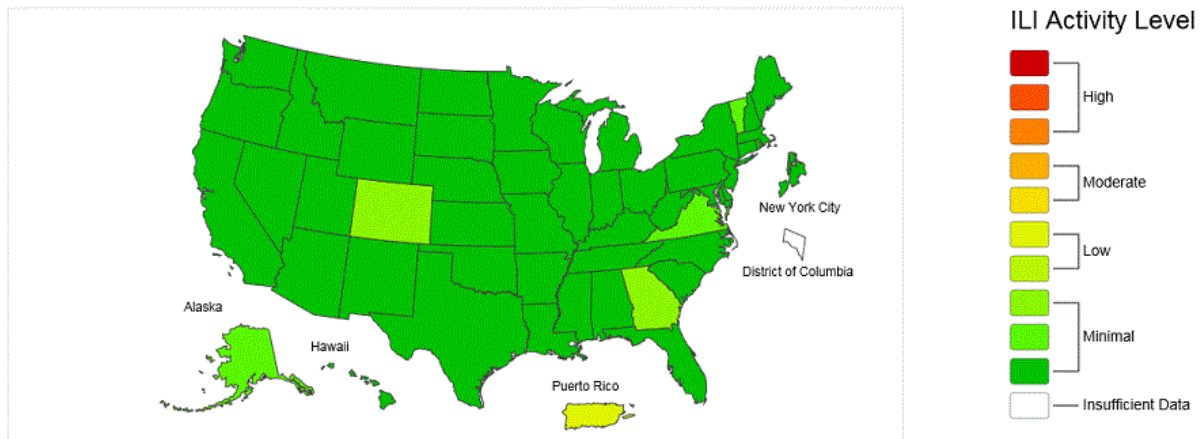
Indiana (Week 41)

Influenza-Like Illness (ILI) Activity Level Indicator Determined by Data Reported to ILINet
2016-17 Influenza Season Week 41 ending Oct 15, 2016



- During Week 41, 1.2% of outpatient visits reported through the U.S. Outpatient Influenza-like Illness Surveillance Network (ILINet) were due to ILI. This is below the national baseline (2.2%).
- No influenza-associated pediatric deaths were reported to CDC during week 41.
- The most frequently identified influenza virus type reported by public health laboratories during week 41 was influenza A. The number of specimens testing positive by virus type: Influenza A 77 (60.2%) and Influenza B 51 (39.8%).
