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Updates on Most Recent Local Activity: Week 46 (Nov 13 – Nov 19)

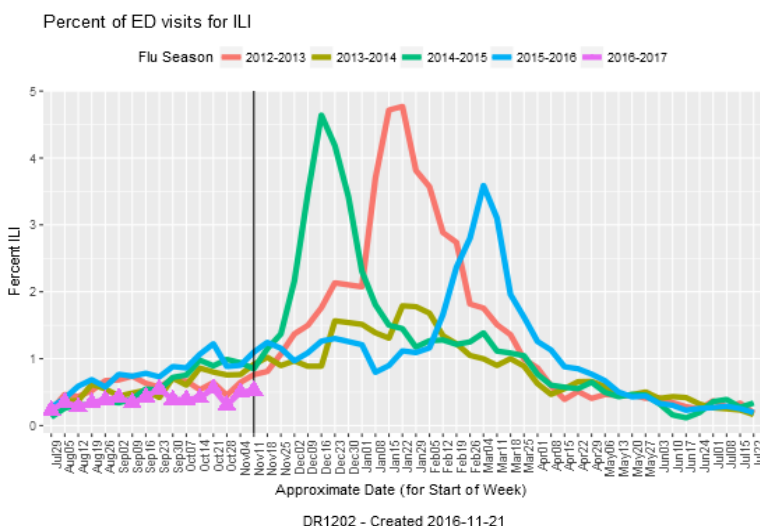
- The percent and count of ILI visits for last week (Week 46) are 0.53% and 52, respectively. These numbers are about the same as the week prior and are also lower for this time of year compared to the previous 4 flu seasons. Note: We are missing data for Friday and Saturday of Week 46 so our numbers will update later.

Local (Week 45)

- The percent and count of ED visits with a chief complaint of ILI was 0.47% and 56 of all ED visits, respectively.
- Children under the age of 5 have the highest age-specific percent ILI (2.2%).

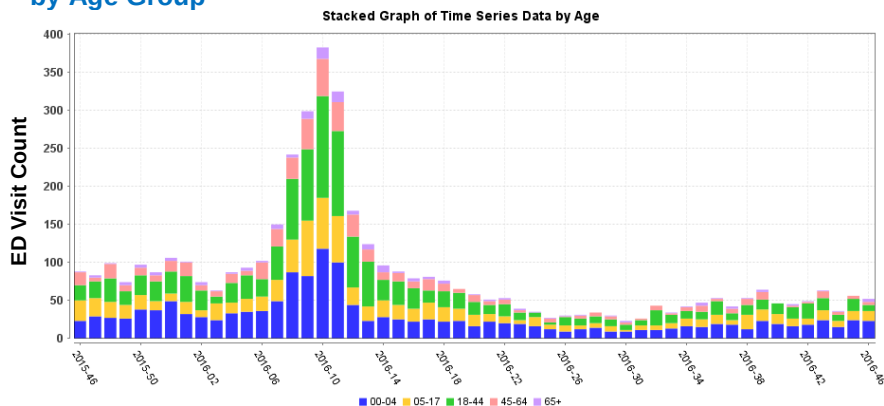

Figure 1 represents the percent of all ED visits that were categorized as ILI. The overall percent ILI for Week 45 is 0.5% (higher than last week).

ILI visit means that the patient reported fever with cough or sore throat, or used the word "flu" to describe either their symptoms or their reason for the ED visit.

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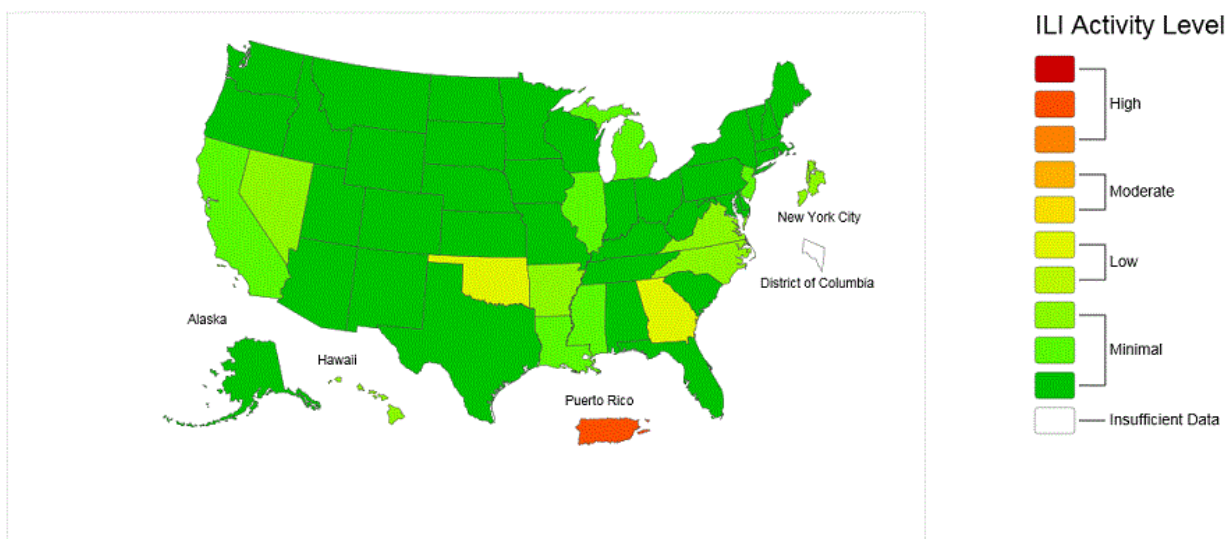
Indiana (Week 45)

Influenza-Like Illness (ILI) Activity Level Indicator Determined by Data Reported to ILINet
2016-17 Influenza Season Week 45 ending Nov 12, 2016



- During Week 45, 1.6% of outpatient visits reported through the U.S. Outpatient Influenza-like Illness Surveillance Network (ILINet) were due to ILI. This is an increase from last week (1.4%) and below the national baseline (2.2%).
- No influenza-associated pediatric deaths were reported to CDC during week 45. There have been 0 influenza-associated pediatric deaths reported during the 2016-2017 season.
- The most frequently identified influenza virus type reported by public health laboratories during week 45 was influenza A (H3). The number of specimens testing positive by virus type: Influenza A 163 (81.9%) and Influenza B 36 (18.1%).
